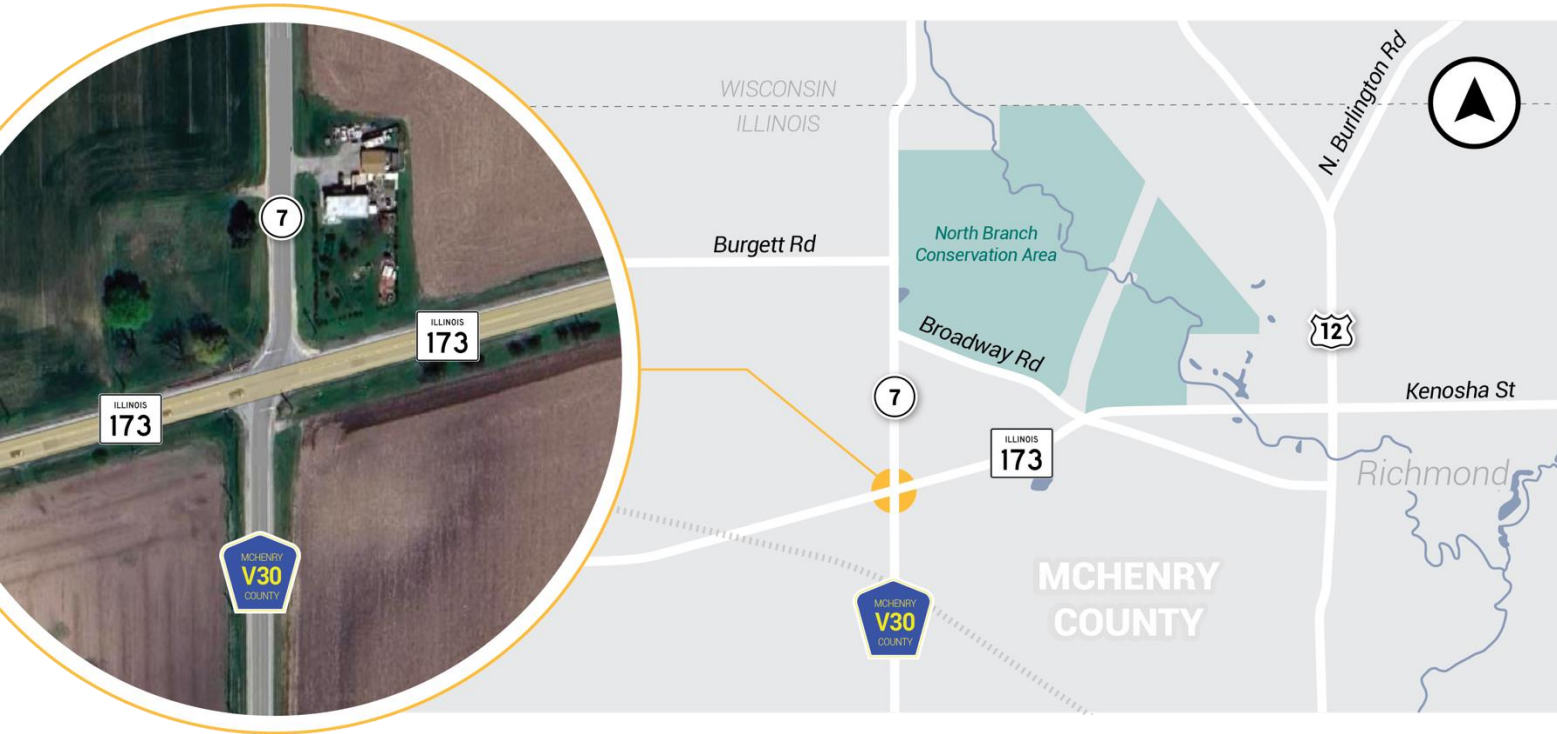

- Two-way, stop-controlled intersection
- Stop signs on Keystone Rd
- Free-flowing traffic on IL 173
- No designated turn lanes at either intersection
